### How to access STUDENT WIFI from an Windows 10 device.

STUDENT WiFi can be used by authorised staff and six form students in accordance to the school's BYOD policy which can be found here

In order to access the STUDENT WIFI system you must carry out the two following steps.

1 Install the EXA certificate.

2 Connect to the School's STUDENT WIFI Wireless.

Step 1 will need to be completed using your 3/4G connection or at home when connected to your wireless.

### Step 1 How to install the EXA certificate

In order to scan for inappropriate content an EXA Networks SSL certificate will need installing on your device before you can use the STUDENT WIFI. The instructions below explain the process of how to install the certificate and then connect the STUDENT WIFI network.

Open up the web browser and go to <u>www.bvgs.co.uk/cert-link</u> which will take you to this page where you need to click Certificate Download.
