#### My Vesey Experience

Initially I was put on the waiting list for Vesey. I was going to go to John Willmott. Often, I consider how my life would've been if that had happened. Instead though, I have been able to benefit from Bishop Vesey and everything it has to offer.

The school has offered me invaluable opportunities for example, the chance to go to parliament as part of the Erdington Youth Parliament programme with my local MP Jack Dromey.

Also, the school has nurtured my interests and passions over the years. Taking Art A-level has meant that I have been able to go on several gallery visits across the country. We have visited exhibitions in Birmingham, Liverpool and London – all of which fuelled my passion for the subject.

This culminated in a suggestion to participate in the ARTiculation prize, where I placed in the regional heat. This gave me access to the ARTiculation alumni programme, putting me in contact with various experts and figures in the art world – a potential way to find work in the future.

The most significant suggestion though was a Cambridge outreach programme. After the suggestion, I found I was eligible and continued to attend two summer schools. Earlier in January I received an offer to study Linguistics at Christ's college Cambridge.

I see this achievement both as a product of my own effort but also of the opportunities that Vesey has offered me. Through financial support, academic guidance and the nourishment of good values the school has enabled me to overcome my situation – without all these opportunities offered by the school my story so far would be very different.
